### **Transportation Notes:**

The bus for pick up and drop off will be a chartered bus for the camp. There will be staff on the bus and they will be identified with a "The YES" sign when they get off at every stop. Staff will also be waiting in Kelowna and Vancouver.

- Please ensure that campers arrive at the bus pick-up points on time. Buses will
  not wait and will leave at the designated times.
- Also, please ensure that transportation plans or pick-ups of campers after camp are well coordinated with bus times.

An evening snack will be provided for participants when they arrive at camp. Please ensure that participants have enough food packed for lunch on the bus, a packed dinner or money to buy dinner on the ferry and any snacks needed. (A lunch will be provided for the return trip.)

## **Drop Off and Pick Up by Car:**

#### Sunday, (First Day of Camp):

 Participants should be dropped off at the campsite at 7pm. Please do not arrive before 6:45pm. The drive from Duncan is approximately 30 min.

#### Saturday, (Last Day of Camp):

- Participants should be picked up from camp by 9 am.
- \*\* We know this is early, but is necessary to get participants home to all parts of the province.

The Camp is held at the Cowichan Lake Outdoor Education Centre (CLEC). The CLEC is located one kilometer west of the town of Lake Cowichan and 96 km from both Victoria and Nanaimo. CLEC is 28 km west of Duncan. The site is at the end of Lakeview Park Rd. contrary to Google Maps' listing.
